DELIVERY OF WORK

The gallery will receive works from **Monday 24 November**

All works, catalogue and contact details must be received by **Friday 28 November**

Exhibition opens at 6pm **Friday 5 December 2025**

Exhibition closes at **4pm Sunday 1 February 2026**

Unsold works must be collected by **Friday 6 February 2026**

SIZE AND MEDIUM

Work may be any shape or medium and no larger than 300mm in height, width or depth.

2D work: maximum 300 x 300mm, 3D work: 300 x 300 x 300mm.

However we still expect to receive works that are small but no larger than these dimensions. This will be strictly adhered to.

We encourage artists to think outside the square. Viewers will be expecting to see anything from paintings to small bronzes, ceramics, glass and jewellery.

RETAIL PRICE

All works must be for sale. There will be no set retail price—however a variety of retail prices are requested upward from \$100 in increments of \$50, ie; \$100, \$150, \$200, \$250, \$300 etc. inclusive of GST. The Gallery's commission is 40% of the retail price inc. of GST. Artists are responsible for their own GST whether registered or not.

ENTRY FEE

\$20 per artist.

This non—refundable entry fee enables you to submit up to 4 works and is payable to the Waiheke Community Art Gallery before or when the work is delivered.

SALES

Work sold may be taken by the buyer as soon as payment is made to the Gallery. Sold works will be replaced with entries received but not yet displayed.

Payments to artists will be made by Direct credit on 20th of the month following completion of sale.

CONDITIONS

- **Artists must live full time or part time on Waiheke Island.**
- This is a 'cash and carry' exhibition, all works must be for sale. The labels for works taken by buyers will be displayed in the gallery.
- Work must be delivered with adequate packaging to enable repacking at end of exhibition. Work must be properly presented for display.
- Artist's name, title of work, medium and retail price (\$100, \$150, \$200, \$250 etc.) must be clearly written on the back or securely attached to each work.
- A completed entry form with full contact details, banking details and works details must be provided by each artist.
- The selection of works is at the discretion of the Director. Where no retail price is provided or the gallery has a differing opinion, the price will be set by the Director, whose decision is final.
- Unsold work must be collected from the gallery the same week as the exhibition closure. Work not collected within the time frame specified will become the property of the gallery and may be sold to defray expenses. Accumulation of works not collected over years have led the gallery implement this policy.
